### **Code of Conduct**

#### Within School

- 1. We will reach school on time, so we are prepared for the day
- 2. We will bring the identity cards to school every day and wear them throughout the day. We will walk quietly in a queue in the corridor and on stairs to maintain discipline and to ensure healthy functioning of our surroundings.
- 3. We will only use those stairs that are assigned to our class.
- 4. We will be mindful to the boards displayed around the school corridors
- 5. We will switch off all the lights and fans when not in use, to save energy.
- 6. We will maintain cleanliness in the classroom and school as it is a sign of healthy living
- 7. We will take good care of school property so that others can use it too.
- 8. We will eat during the break time in designated areas only. Learners who bring home cooked food may sit in the classroom during break time, whereas those who take school lunch must eat in the designated area.
- 9. We can eat non-oily or dry food like almonds, cashews etc during the Class, with the permission of the teacher in the classroom.
- 10. We will not waste and throw food in garbage in bins.

### Within Classes

- 4. We will pay attention and cooperate with our teachers

- 7. We will treat each other with respect and care, avoiding spoken or written words or actions which cause emotional or physical injury, or which intimidate or humiliate
- 8. We must take good care of their health and keep themselves physically fit and strong.
- 9. We mustn't hesitate to say 'NO' when asked or tempted to do a thing, which they know is wrong.
- 10. We must respect the liberty and rights of others.
- 11. We should look upon people from all parts of the world and all walks of life as their brethren irrespective of their caste, color, and creed.
- 12. We must not throw things outside the window, physically hurting anyone inside the classroom, in the corridor or outside the school, throwing any object at anyone is strictly forbidden.

## With Mobile and Digital technology
